Argentina is the world's best destination for high-limit duck, high-volume dove and perdiz (partridge) hunting and this Lodge is the premiere destination in Argentina for wingshooting and fishing! You will be amazed by the sheer volume of duck and dove you will hunt in our private shooting areas. There are more than 12 common duck species in our hunting area: Speckled Teal, Yellow Billed Pintail, Rosy-Billed Pochard, White-faced Whistling Duck, Fulvous Whistling Duck, Silver Teal, Red Shoveler, Southern Widgeon, Cinnamon Teal, White-Cheeked Pintail, Black-headed Duck and Ring Teal.

This outfitter offers incredible high-volume dove shooting. Near the lodge, he has private fields where hunters can shoot 500 rounds or more in a single afternoon! Some afternoons, you will be shooting Perdiz in the rich pastures near the lodge. His experienced guides will work with their team of well-trained pointers to provide you with an exciting upland hunting experience!

This Lodge offers the ultimate fishing program in Argentina where you can fight the mighty Golden Dorado or reel in huge Surubies (cat fish) or toothy piranha!

Thanks to its temper and voracity when feeding, the Golden Dorado is nicknamed "The Tiger of the Rivers". Its fighting strength and acrobatic jumps will challenge every angler's skills! The Parana River together with its wetlands contains over 220 species of fish, making it one of the greatest environments of biodiversity on earth.

We fish for Golden Dorado using any of the following techniques: artificial fly, bait casting, spinning or trolling. The Golden Dorado can be captured in the "rapids" of the islands of the Parana River when passing near San Javier, in the province of Santa Fe.

Golden Dorado fishing is considered as one of the most exciting and exhilarating types of freshwater sport fishing in the world! Once hooked, your challenge is in landing the fish due to its intense fighting strength and acrobatic jumps. There is no other freshwater species as combative as the Golden Dorado! At this Lodge, our professional fishing guides...the most experienced in the region... have been guiding international anglers for over 15 years. Our fast boats are specifically designed for casting; combined with the expertise of our guides, your fishing trip will be an unparalleled experience!



Surubie (Cat Fish)

During the Winter Season and with adequate water temperature, it is normal to have between 15-30 fishing peaks per day (of course, factors such as meteorological conditions and the rises of the river may impact the number of peaks).

The Lodge is situated on the majestic Parana River in an untamed and natural habitat that provides the best hunting and fishing in Argentina. At the Lodge you will never go hungry! Breakfast, lunch and dinner are served daily with snacks and hors d'oeuvres available throughout the day.

TAKING FIREARMS TO ARGENTINA FOR HUNTING OR SHOOTING as of 1/1/15

Visitors who may wish to import firearms for hunting or target general are advised to apply for a temporary import permit at the Consulate. The following materials/information is required:

1. Valid passport (original)
2. 2 recent passport style photographs.
3. Valid US firearms/hunting license or permit (original)
4. Type of firearms (including model, make, serial number and gauge)
5. Type and quantity of ammunition.
6. Owner's current address in the United States, and temporary address in Argentina, including telephone numbers.
7. Hunting location (ranch, nearest city/town and province) in Argentina.
8. Airplane ticket with arrival and departure dates.
9. Processing fee: US\$ 40, payable by **money order only (recommended U.S. Postal Service Money Order)**. Make it

payable to the "Consulate General of Argentina". **They do not accept cash or checks.** Processed within 7 (seven) working days. Please be aware that **it is no longer possible to submit applications by mail. Without exception**, all temporary import permit applicants are requested to present themselves at the Consulate to sign the form and have their fingerprints taken **with appointment only**. To request an appointment please send an email to: legal@consuladofargentina.net The Consulate's Legal Department is open Monday through Friday from 9 am to 12 pm.
