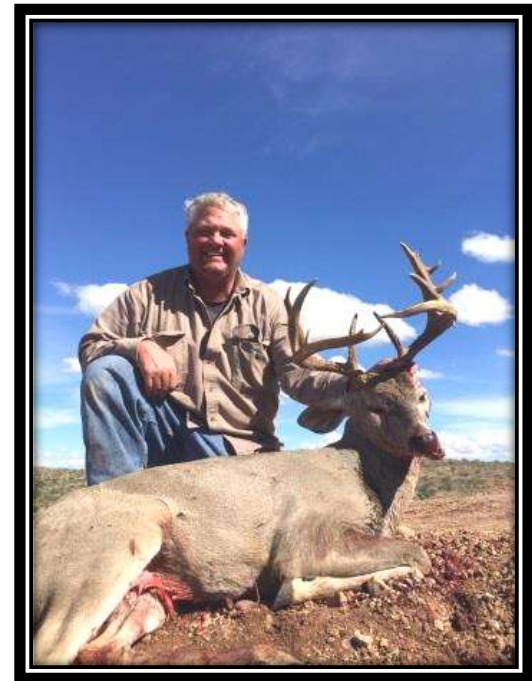
HUNT FOR MULE DEER

This lodge is located 173 miles from U.S. border (Arizona) in the central part of the state of Sonora, Mexico. Flights are the best way to come to Hermosillo. There are flights from Phoenix, Tucson & Los Angeles. Arriving through Phoenix will be the best option. Air carriers are Aero México and US Airways.

What to bring: •Passport, Field Bag (small), Ventilated, Wide-Brimmed Hat, Shooting Glasses, Soft case for your shotgun, Personal Toiletries & Medications, Small Flashlight, Lightweight Shooting Vest (dove/quail), Sunscreen, Insect Repellent, Hearing Protection, Sturdy, Comfortable Boots, Camera/Video, Binoculars (deer)

What to Wear: for Doves, Quail, Water fowl & Pheasant: We recommend light, comfortable all weather beige and/or camouflage colors, as well as a wide-brimmed, ventilated hat. The temperatures during season can range anywhere from the 50s to the 90s. During dove and quail hunts, your bird boys will retrieve your doves/quail, so you can wear shorts without worrying about sharp branches and thorns. You may also consider a shoulder-worn recoil pad because of the high volume shooting. For Mule deer, Coues deer, Turkey & Desert sheep: We recommend light, comfortable all weather clothing in camouflage colors, a pair of very comfortable walking boots. The temperatures during deer season can range anywhere from the 30s to the 90s, so bringing a camo jacket will be a good idea as a pair of gloves. Dress in layers and be able to peel off. It can be chilly in the mornings and evenings. Good pair of binoculars and a range finder is a must. Also a backpack and a soft case for your guns is recommended.

[Conditions](#), [Release of Liability](#) and the [Hunting Contract](#). Upon entry into the U.S. with a trophy, present to authorities your [Wildlife Declaration Form 3-177](#). Have address of your taxidermist readily available. All clients must comply with the U.S. Department of the Interior/Fish and Wildlife Services laws, requirements and conditions.
