Jungle Camp – Nuevo Becal

This camp is a 4 hour drive from Campeche and is deep in the jungle on 50,000 acres next to 4,500,000 acres of National Reserve making for a very unique and special kind of hunting experience with an opportunity to harvest special trophies. The camp has beds with clean sheets, mosquito nets, bath towels and is furnished with African style air-conditioning. This Camp has a limited chance of harvesting Red Brocket Deer which is the most difficult to collect.

Late February and March is the time that the Mapola (Flamboyant) and Zapote trees drop their fruit and the Red Brocket Deer love this fruit. April is dry and good for hunting all the animals but it is very HOT. Nauche, Catalosh and Nilchi trees drop their fruit during this time and the guides naturally know where all of these trees are located. During the dry season, water holes are popular areas to set up and wait for animals.

PRICE INCLUDES: ground transportation to/from Campeche International Airport to the hunting camp; classic safari style camp with wooden and palapa cabins, traditional local gourmet food & drinks; guides; transportation during the hunt; trophy fee of first species (brocket Deer or Ocellated Turkey); caping and salt drying.

PRICE EXCLUDES: CITES permit (if necessary), temporary Federal Gun Importation permit, State and Federal Taxes and Conservation fee (\$500); license fees; tips; hotel expenses before and after the hunt, trophy shipment; special food; cost of medications; immunizations; hospitalizations and services or products that are not agreed or mentioned in this document.

A Mexican CITES COUNTRY OF ORIGIN Export Permit is required for the Curassow, Crested Guan, Ocellated Turkey, White Lipped Peccary, Coati Mundi and the Chachalaca; however, one CITES permit can handle all species.
