## **HUNT WHITE-LIPPED and COLLARED PECCARY IN MEXICO**

(Tayassu pecari) and (Tayassu tajacu)

The adult White-Lipped peccary vary in size from 60 lbs. to 89 lbs. There is no external sexual dimorphism, but the canine teeth of the male are longer. They prefer the vast primary tropical, moist forests and avoid habitats disturbed by, or in proximity to humans. They travel in large packs frequently numbering up to 100 or 200 animals of both sexes. They seem to be more active at twilight and are very noisy animals. Their presence is also given away by the powerful musky odor emitted by the dorsal scent gland.



The adult Collared peccary range from Arizona and

Texas through Mexico and Central America all the way to Peru. The adult averages between 31 and 53 lbs. Their habitats are varied ranging from tropical forests to thorn forests, and semi-desert brushwood. They live in permanent groups consisting of both sexes and their group size varies with the region. They can be active at any time of the day but are more likely to move in the morning and afternoon. They mark their territory with feces and musk of the dorsal gland

and they also use the gland to mark each other.

The Mayatla Ravine runs through this ranch at an altitude of 2,300'.

Mexican CITES II Country of Origin Export Permit required for White-Lipped Peccary. None required for Collared Peccary. No U.S. CITES Import Permit required upon return.

You will travel to Veracruz, Veracruz, Mexico

United Airlines departs Houston and arrives in Veracruz at 8:00 PM. Stay overnight in a hotel. Hotel recommended.
