This hunt has extensive horseback riding and considerable walking. Some knowledge and experience with horses and riding is a must. Physical condition is an important factor in the stalking part of the hunt. Tent camp will have a generator at 5,100'.

- Day 2 2 hour flight to Mineralny Vody and transfer to Karachaevsk and overnight
- Day 3 Transfer to hunting camp
- Day 4-10 Hunting days (7) 1 x 1
- Day 11 Return to Karachaevsk, overnight
- Day 12 Flight to Moscow and depart for home
