**BECEITE IBEX \$7,950**

(*Capra pyrenaica hispanica*)  
 This is the largest and darkest type with the largest horns. Typically the horns are straighter than the Gredos Ibex and have a spiral turn of less than 180°. Typically, horn thickness remains constant for half length, and then decreases towards the tip, which is not as thin as the Gredos race.

**GREDOS IBEX \$7,950**

(*Capra pyrenaica victoriae*)

After the Beceite Ibex, this is the largest and darkest color Ibex with larger horns. Typically the horns are layer-shaped with a pronounced curve and spiral turn of more than 180°. Horn thickness decreases progressively from the base to the tip.



Areas	Season
Southeastern mountains and natural reserves of Tejada, Sierra Nevada, Lujar, Cazorla and Almeria.	October to end of May

**SOUTHEASTERN IBEX**

(*Capra pyrenaica hispanica*)

This ibex is smaller and lighter in color than the Beceite and Gredos types but larger and darker than the Ronda. Horn size and shape vary considerably from place to place, with those from Sierra Nevada generally, the largest. Horns from Tejada Almijara tend to be the most distinctive, forming a circle with the tips growing towards the neck like those of a Mouflon. The keel is smooth, making the horns almost round in cross section.

**RONDA IBEX \$7,950**  
(*Capra pyrenaica hispanica*)

This is the smallest type of Spanish Ibex. Overall color is light brown. The horns resemble those of an Alpine Ibex, typically growing in a V shape, then backwards with a spiral turn of 90°. Typically, horn thickens remains constant for half length, then decreases gradually to the boomed tips.

**Getting to Spain:** Arrive in Madrid where you will be met by an agent and helped to clear customs. We recommend that our customers fly with American Airlines, Iberia, Delta or Continental Airlines. They have direct flights from Miami, Boston, New York, Atlanta, Washington, Philadelphia or Chicago.

The temperature in April, May, June and September is from 68°F to 86°F with a 30% possibility of rain. In October and November the temperature is from 50°F to 68°F with a 20% possibility of rain. In December and January the temperature is between 40°F and 60°F with snow in the high mountains. In the fall and winter we recommend wearing long trousers, long sleeved shirts, woolen sweaters, waterproof clothing, hunting boots, hunting down jacket and bring along a casual dinner jacket. In the spring and summer shorts, short sleeved jackets, hat and light hunting jacket are appropriate. All clothing should be dark green, camouflage or brown in color. We also recommend a good light weight pair of binoculars.
