TRAVEL CHECK LIST

PAPERS

- _ Passport, Visa, Firearm Permit, Letter of Invitation
- _ Folder to keep papers handy at all times
- _ Airline tickets and itinerary
- _ Insurance – Global Rescue
- _ Cash for payments in the hunting area
- _ Cards for payments in hotels and restaurants
- _ CITES Import Permit
- _ List of addresses & phone numbers home and abroad and hunting destinations, taxidermy address, travel agent, USFW office & US port of entry if returning with CITES trophies
- _ Diary & pen
- _ Maps & Reading Material

CLOTHING

- _ Mountain boots - NOT NEW! – 1 or 2 pair that are good for climbing
- _ Boot grease
- _ Camp shoes
- _ Gor-Tex Gaiters
- _ Hunting pants – 2 pair
- _ Hunting shirt (long-sleeved) -2
- _ Underwear – 3 or 4 pair
- _ Rain wear (a necessity for all hunts)
- _ Sweater – 1 or 2
- _ Vest (down)
- _ Thermal top, long-sleeved
- _ T-Shirts – 3 or 4
- _ Gloves – 2 pair (1 warm, or mittens)
- _ Wool cap
- _ Cap with ear flaps (for October)
- _ Hunting cap, camo or dark colored
- _ Neck Gator (baklava)
- _ Leather belt or suspenders
- _ Socks, light and warm or thermo
- _ Handkerchiefs
- _ Snow Camo pants and jacket w/hood & backpack cover
- _ Clothing for return trip home

FIREARMS & AMMO

- _ Lightweight rifle cal.7 mm Rem., 300 Win Mag with optics 3-9x or above
- _ Rifle case: hard one and soft one (for car and horseback transportation)
- _ Ammo: in original container (some carriers require a hard, lockable case)
- _ Cleaning kit
- _ Lens cleaner
- _ Pocket-knife

OPTICS

- _ Binoculars, 10x or 12x
- _ Spotting scope, 50x or 60x
- _ Rangefinder
- _ Tripod

MISCELLANEOUS

- _ Sleeping bag (for 14°F/10°C)
- _ Pad for sleeping (body size) and sitting
- _ Insect repellent for all hunts and mosquito repellent and net for Sheep & Musk Ox
- _ Lip balm & sun block
- _ Walking stick (Sheep and Tur hunt)
- _ Blister pads
- _ Duffle bag for your trophy, water-proof shipping tags
- _ Plastic bags – 3 - 5 large size
- _ 6' long, clear yard leaf bag – emergency weather or bivouac shelter
- _ Daypack
- _ Water bottle or thermos, two 1 liter bottles
- _ Medications
- _ DIAMOX (up to your doctor recommendation, for altitude)
- _ Toiletries
- _ Duct tape
- _ Zip-lock bags
- _ Cameras (photo, video)
- _ Film, tapes, memory cards
- _ Flashlight
- _ Satellite phone-9505 Iridium (rent or buy)
- _ MP-3 Player or Radio
- _ Batteries (EXTRA!), Chargers (22v or adapter), Solar charger
- _ Sunglasses
- _ Reading glasses
- _ Food snacks-soup-jerky-candy
- _ 25' parachute cord, 1/8"
- _ Fire making equipment
- _ Two or three fish hooks and line
- _ Two large safety pins
- _ Ear plugs
